COLOR MIXING

In order to get a nice grey by mixing colors, try:

1. Burnt Sienna and French Ultramarine; or
2. Dioxanine Violet and Hooker's Green

Remember, you can mix on your palette but allowing the pigments to mix on your paper will give a nice translucency and a better variation in color as it dries. Also, French Ultra is a granulating pigment so this also gives added interest to your painting.
